



Exhibitor Expectations

Exhibitors are expected to treat volunteer committee members with courtesy and respect at all times. Staff directions from McGee Park and 4 Corners Energy Committee members are to be followed.

The 4 Corners Energy Conference is open to individuals over the age of 18, whom are employed by the energy industry and affiliated businesses. Inform employees that they need to show company identification, business card or be wearing a uniform for admission to the conference. Children are NOT allowed admittance to the conference. No pets are allowed except for Certified Service Animals. There is no admission fee to attend the conference.

- **Attendance**

All booths will be physically manned from 8 am until 5:00 pm on Wednesday May 6th and from 8 am until 2 pm on Thursday May 7th.

- **Name tags**

All vendors and Sponsors will be issued name tags and that are provided by 4 Corners Energy Conference while in attendance at the show.

- **Removal of Exhibits**

The **exhibitor agrees that no display will be dismantled or goods removed during the entire run of the show until 2 pm on Thursday, May 7th**. As per signed contract failure to comply will result in penalty of 25% of the total cost of the contracted exhibit space.

- **Safety is our utmost Concern**

Please take your time and be careful while setting up and tearing down. Make sure personnel are qualified to run equipment.

- **No outside Alcohol is to be consumed or open containers during exhibit hours.**

Shipping Information:

Large items, or equipment **CANNOT ARRIVE at McGee Park PRIOR TO Friday May 1, 2026.** They can not accept any UPS items prior to **April 24, 2026.** Please be aware that items shipped to McGee Park will be placed in the booth by 4 Corners Energy Conference and will have a service fee assessed. Arrangements for pick-up also need to be made. McGee Park will also handle the items being shipped out after the show, the vendors must attached the printed return label to the items they are shipping back. FCEC will do return shipping for a fee.

Outdoor Exhibitor Information

Check-in: **Monday, May 4, 2026 Outdoor Exhibitors ONLY!**

8:00 am - 4:00 pm

Check-out: **Friday, May 8, 2026 Outdoor Exhibitors**

8:00 am - 12:00 pm

Outdoor Exhibitors will check-in on **Monday, May 4, 2026 ONLY**. This will allow outdoor exhibitors to set-up in a safer environment. Display booths are 20' deep x 30' long. 1 table and two chairs are provided with outdoor booths. You may order those items from McGee Park or supply your own. Be courteous of your neighbors. If you are running equipment and it is too noisy for your neighbors you will be required to turn it off. McGee Park has a 6,000 lb forklift that will be available for the outside booths.

Outside booths must be manned, **NO** unmanned displays allowed. Electricity, table and chairs are available for outside booths.

- company identification sign
- one 6 ft. draped table
- two chairs
- electricity - one plug
- includes two (2) conference badges with two lunch vouchers for each day

Booth carpeting is **NOT** included.

- Equipment or large display items **cannot** arrive prior to Friday May 1, 2026.
- Midway displays next to the convention center and multi-purpose buildings must be removed **by 12:00 pm on Friday May 8** to accommodate the next event scheduled at the venue.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the loading and unloading of their own equipment for display. McGee Park will provide forklifts for outdoor exhibits.
- Large displays need to arrive early in the morning on Monday, May 4th to be unloaded and positioned first. Large displays must be removed from the midway by noon on Friday, May 8th to accommodate the next event scheduled at McGee Park.
- Display equipment must be clean and in good condition with no hazardous material in tanks or on premises. No leaking equipment will be tolerated.
- Do not use stakes in the pavement. Use wheel chocks as appropriate. Use cribbing for heavy displays so the pavement will not be damaged.
- Weight limits of displays will be set by McGee Park staff. If you display needs overweight DOT permits please call McGee Park 505-325-5415.
- Safety is our utmost concern. Please make sure employees are certified for equipment they are running and are wearing the required safety items.
- No outside Alcohol is to be consumed or open containers during exhibit hours.

OUTDOOR BOOTHS

- Refunds will not be given to outdoor exhibitors due to weather conditions.
- All booths will be manned from 8 am until 4 pm on Wednesday, May 6th and from 8 am until 2 pm on Thursday, May 7th. No unmanned displays allowed.
- Be courteous of your neighbors. Equipment and that is too noisy for your neighbors will be required to be turned off.

Indoor Exhibitors Only!

Indoor Exhibitors will check-in on **Tuesday, May 5, 2026**. Display booths are 10'x10' and have back and side draping, one draped table and two chairs, a company identification sign, and one electrical outlet. **Aisles and individual booths are NOT CARPETED.**

Indoor Exhibit Booth - Standard 10' x 10' Inside Exhibit booth in the Convention Center on the isle, with an 8 ft high draping back wall and 3 ft. wall side rails, Includes:

- company identification sign
- one 6 ft. draped table
- electricity - one plug
- includes two (2) conference badges with two lunch vouchers for each day booth carpeting is NOT included.
- Exhibitors with large items/vehicles/displays that need a forklift must be ready to check-in at 8am 5/5/26

Those items will be first to move in and last to move out. Arrangements for forklift needs to be made through FCEC. **ONLY McGee Park** forklifts with **McGee Park** personnel may operate inside of the build-ings. Weight limits of displays will be set by McGee Park staff. Please call if the intended display is over-weight.

- All inside convention booths (#100 through #699) are supplied with one electrical outlet. Exhibitors must provide extension cord and power strip for exhibit.
- Displays placed in the inside booth space shall not be higher than 10 feet and shall not protrude into the aisle.
- Engines can not be run inside the exhibit halls. Items with gasoline/diesel tanks must have less than a quarter tank of fuel in the tank.
- Display equipment must be clean and in good condition with no hazardous material in tanks or on premises. No leaking equipment will be tolerated.
- McGee Park has a weight limit for display items. Please call for heavy items.
- Audio devices must be kept at a conversational level and must not interfere with other exhibitors displays. Audio devices may be supplied by exhibitor.
- No exhibitor shall assign, sublet or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted, nor exhibit therein, nor permit any other person or party to exhibit therein, any goods, apparatus etc. not manufactured or distributed by the exhibitor in the regular course of business.
- Convention Center booths must be in place by 8 p.m. Tuesday, May 5th. No unmanned displays allowed. All booths will be manned from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. on Wednesday, May 6th and from 8 a.m. until 2 p.m. on Thursday, May 7th, 2026.
- The exhibitor agrees that no display will be dismantled or goods removed during the entire run of the show until 2 pm on Thursday. As per signed contract Failure to comply will result in penalty of 25% of the total cost of the contracted exhibit space. Additionally, the exhibitor shall be prevented from showing in the next 4 Corners Oil and Gas Conference

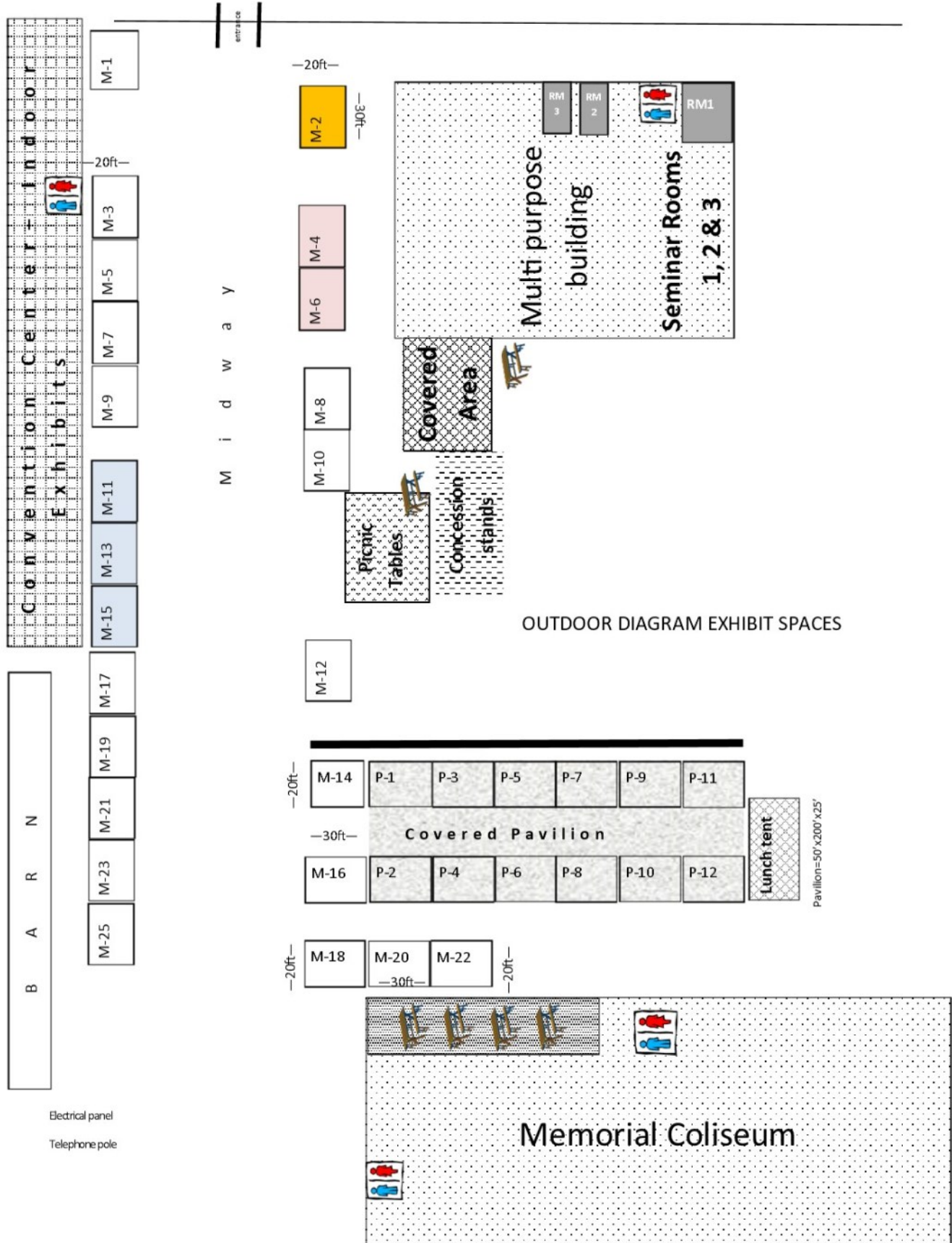

Driving Directions to McGee Park

From Farmington, Bloomfield, or Aztec

McGee Park and Coliseum is located within the outer Farmington city limits and is easy to see from US Hwy 64. If you're staying in **Farmington**, just head eastbound on Hwy 64 for approximately 6 minutes and you will see McGee Park (as well as SunRay Park & Casino's neon lights) on your right hand side.

If you are staying in **Aztec**, the easiest route would be to head south on State Hwy 544 to Bloomfield and turn right (west) on US Hwy 64. From Bloomfield, keep going westbound on Hwy 64 for approximately 13 minutes and you will see McGee Park (as well as SunRay Park & Casino's neon lights) on your left hand side.

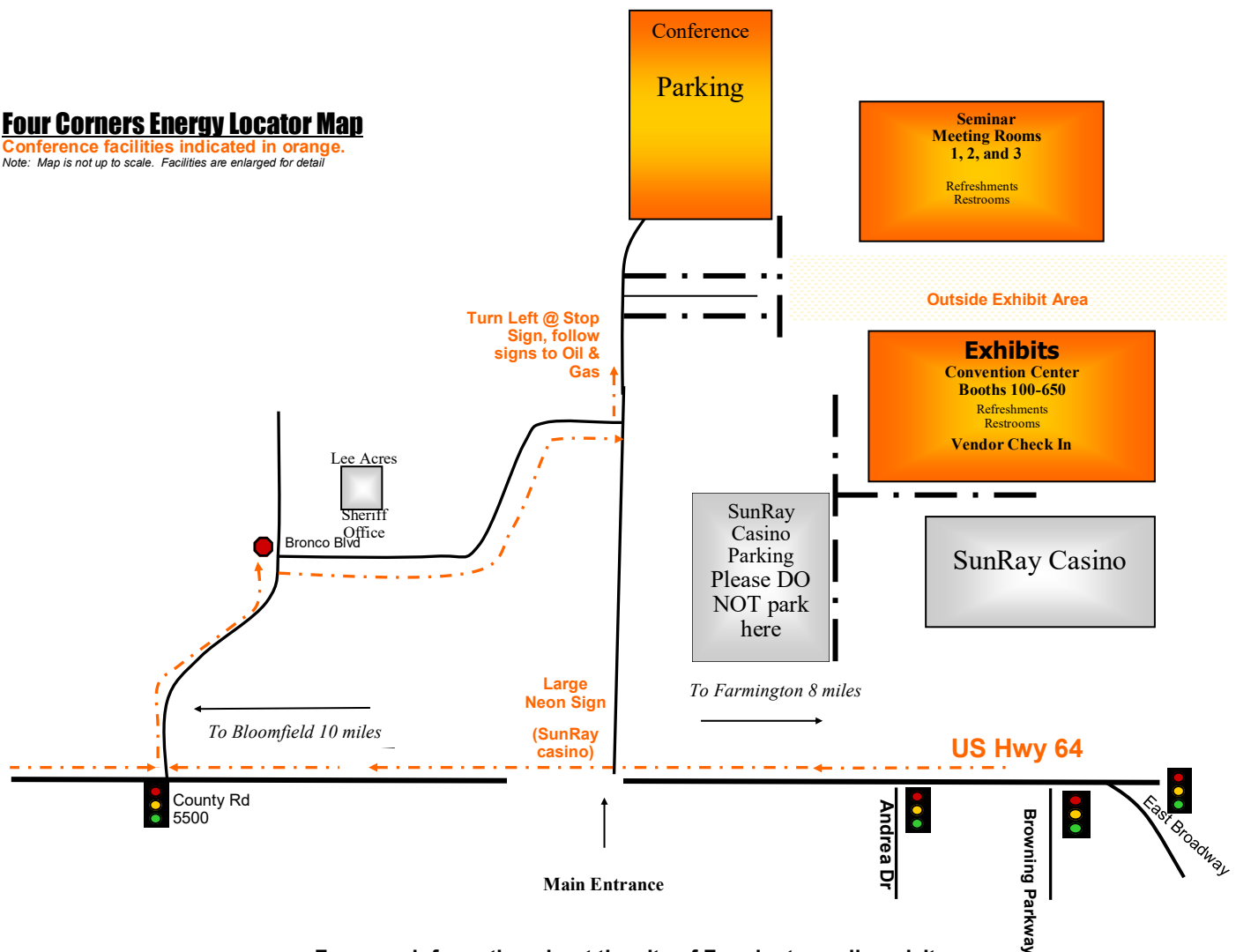
