



Exhibitor Expectations

Exhibitors are expected to treat volunteer committee members with courtesy and respect at all times. Staff directions from McGee Park and 4 Corners Energy Committee members are to be followed.

The 4 Corners Energy Conference is open to individuals over the age of 18, whom are employed by the energy industry and affiliated businesses. Inform employees that they need to show company identification, business card or be wearing a uniform for admission to the conference. Children are NOT allowed admittance to the conference. No pets are allowed except for Certified Service Animals. There is no admission fee to attend the conference.

- **Attendance**

All booths will be physically manned from 8 am until 5 pm on Wednesday May 6th and from 8 am until 2 pm on Thursday May 7th.

- **Name tags**

All vendors and sponsors will be issued name tags to wear while in attendance at the show.

- **Removal of Exhibits**

The **exhibitor agrees that no display will be dismantled or goods re-moved during the entire run of the show until 2 pm on Thursday, May 7th**. As per signed contract failure to comply will result in penalty of 25% of the total cost of the contracted exhibit space.

- **Safety is our utmost Concern**

Please take your time and be careful while setting up and tearing down. Make sure personnel are qualified to run equipment.

- **No outside alcohol is to be consumed or open containers during exhibit hours.**

Shipping Information:

Large items, or equipment **CANNOT ARRIVE at McGee Park PRIOR TO Friday May 1, 2026.** They can not accept any UPS items prior to **April 24, 2026.** Please be aware that items shipped to McGee Park will be placed in the booth by 4 Corners Energy Conference and will have a service fee assessed. McGee Park will also handle the items being shipped out after the show, the vendors must attached the printed return label to the items they are shipping back.

Outdoor Booth Set-Up

Outdoor Exhibitor Information

Outdoor exhibitors must check in exclusively on **Monday, May 4, 2026**. This check-in schedule is established to ensure a safe setup environment. Each outdoor display booth measures 20' deep by 30' long and includes one table and two chairs; additional items may be ordered from McGee Park or supplied by exhibitors. Please be considerate of neighboring exhibitors. Equipment or displays that produce excessive noise must cease operation when requested.

McGee Park provides a 6,000 lb forklift for outdoor booths. All outdoor exhibits must be staffed at all times; unattended displays are strictly prohibited. Electricity, tables, and chairs can be requested as needed.

Each outdoor booth includes:

- Company identification sign
- One 6 ft. draped table
- Two chairs
- One electrical outlet
- Two conference badges with two lunch vouchers per day

Booth carpeting is **not** included. Equipment or large displays may not arrive before May 1, 2026. Displays adjacent to the convention center and multipurpose buildings must be removed **by 12:00 pm on May 8th** to accommodate following events.

Exhibitors are responsible for their own loading and unloading; forklifts are available for outdoor exhibits. Large displays should arrive early on May 4th for unloading and positioning and must be removed from the midway by noon on May 8th. All equipment must be clean, in good condition, and free of hazardous materials; leaking equipment will not be permitted.

To protect pavement, do not use stakes; use wheel chocks and cribbing for heavy displays. McGee Park staff determine weight limits for displays. If overweight DOT permits are required, please contact McGee Park at 505-325-5415.

Safety is the top priority. All personnel operating equipment must be certified and use proper safety gear. Outside alcohol or open containers are strictly prohibited during exhibit hours. No refunds for weather-related cancellations.

All booths must be attended from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm on Wednesday, May 6th, and 8:00 am – 2:00 pm on Thursday, May 7th. Unattended displays are not allowed. Space reservations are not finalized until March 1, 2026, and preferences cannot be guaranteed.



Indoor Booth Set-Up

Indoor Exhibitor Information

Indoor exhibitors are scheduled to check in on **Tuesday, May 5, 2026**. Standard indoor booths measure 10' x 10' and feature an 8 ft high back and 3 ft side draping, one draped table, two chairs, a company identification sign, and one electrical outlet. Neither aisles nor individual booths are carpeted.

Each indoor exhibit booth includes:

- Company identification sign
- One 6 ft. draped table
- Two chairs
- One electrical outlet
- Two conference badges with two lunch vouchers per day

All indoor booths (numbers 100–699) are supplied with one electrical outlet; exhibitors must bring their own extension cords and power strips if required. Display structures may not exceed 10 feet in height or extend into the aisle. Engines may not be operated inside the exhibit halls, and any item containing fuel must have less than a quarter tank.

Exhibitors with sizable items, vehicles, or displays needing forklift assistance must be ready to check in by 8:00 am on May 5th, 2026. These items will be the first to move in and last to move out.

Arrangements for forklift use must be made through FCEC. Only McGee Park forklifts operated by McGee Park personnel are permitted inside buildings. Weight limits for displays are set by McGee Park staff; please call if your intended display exceeds these limits.

All equipment must be clean, in good condition, and free of hazardous materials and leaks. Audio devices must remain at a conversational volume and not disturb other exhibitors.

Subletting, assigning, or dividing booth space is prohibited, as is displaying goods not manufactured or distributed by the exhibitor in their regular course of business.

Convention Center booths must be installed by 8:00 pm on Tuesday, May 5th, and cannot be left unattended. Booths must be staffed between 8:00 am – 4:00 pm on Wednesday, May 6th, and 8:00 am – 2:00 pm on Thursday, May 7th, 2026.

Displays may not be dismantled nor goods removed before 2:00 pm on Thursday. Failure to comply, as stipulated in the signed contract, will result in a penalty of 25% of the total exhibit cost and exclusion from future participation in the 4 Corners Oil and Gas Conference.

The consumption of outside alcohol or open containers during exhibit hours is strictly forbidden.

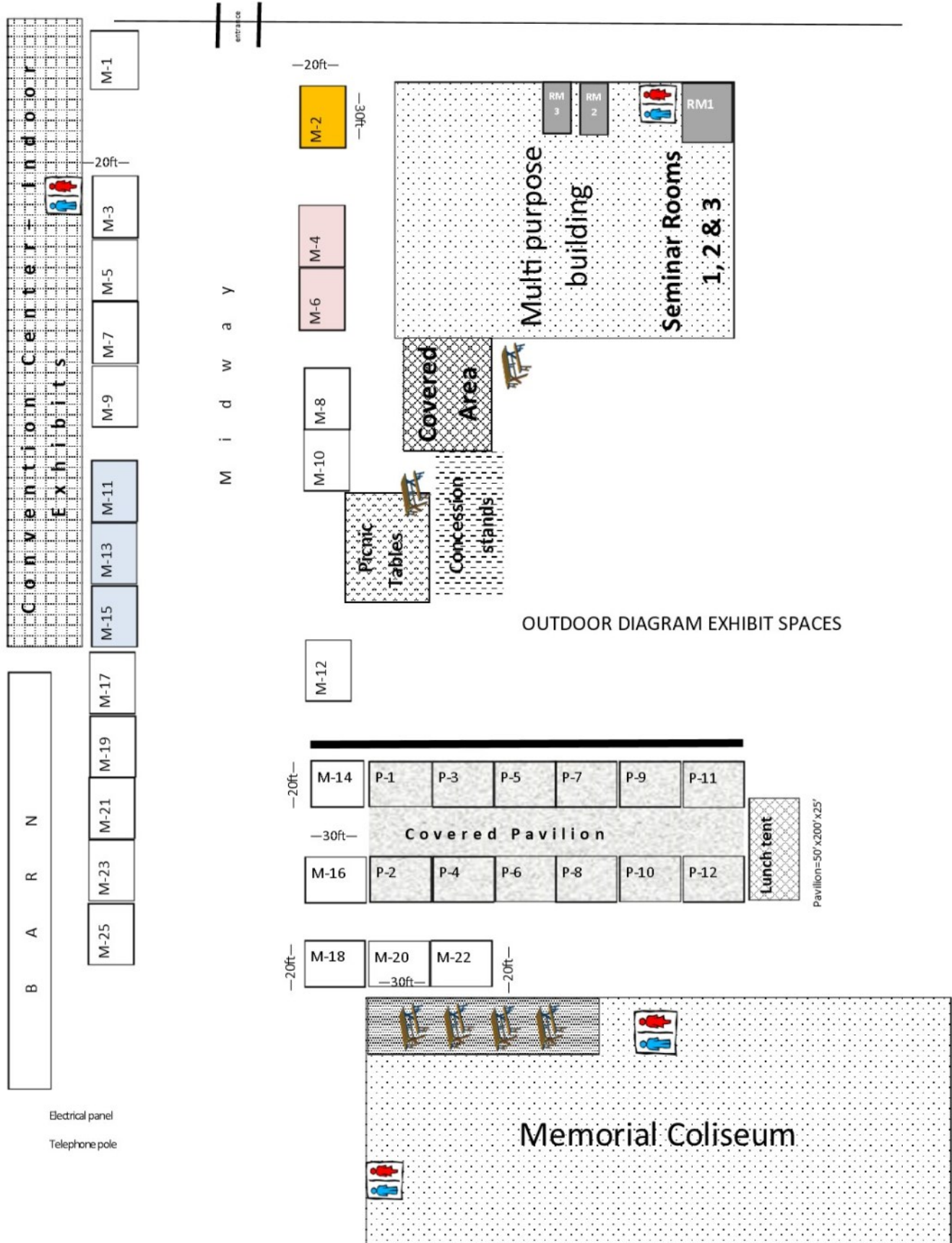

Driving Directions to McGee Park

From Farmington, Bloomfield, or Aztec

McGee Park and Coliseum is located within the outer Farmington city limits and is easy to see from US Hwy 64. If you're staying in **Farmington**, just head eastbound on Hwy 64 for approximately 6 minutes and you will see McGee Park (as well as SunRay Park & Casino's neon lights) on your right hand side.

If you are staying in **Aztec**, the easiest route would be to head south on State Hwy 544 to Bloomfield and turn right (west) on US Hwy 64. From Bloomfield, keep going westbound on Hwy 64 for approximately 13 minutes and you will see McGee Park (as well as SunRay Park & Casino's neon lights) on your left hand side.

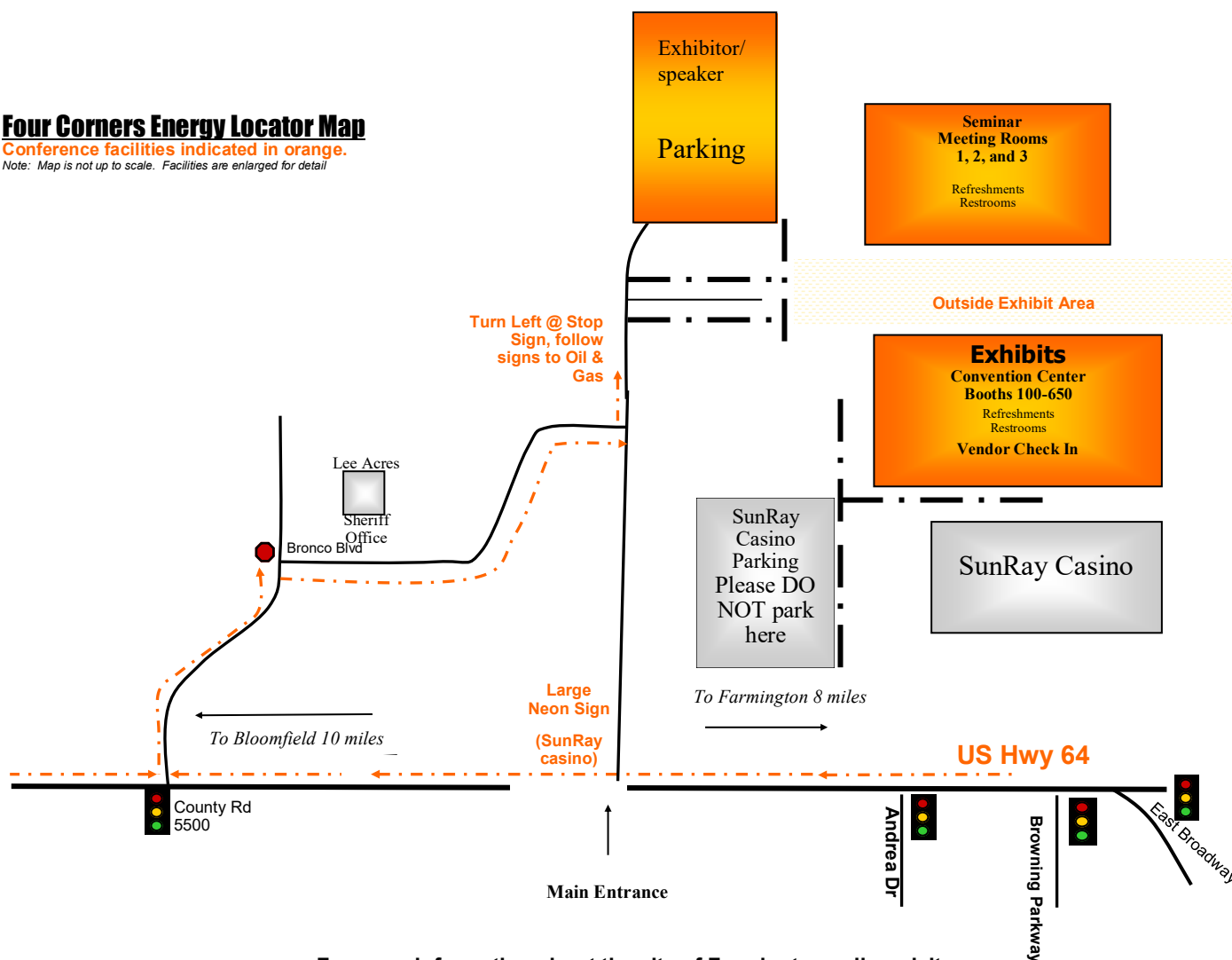
